HAPPENING IN TIGRAY?

On November 4, 2020, the Ethiopian government declared war on Tigray (the northernmost region of Ethiopia) and subsequently enforced a communications blackout.

Since then, it has been reported that:

- ✓ 600,000+ civilians have been killed
- ✓ 5.2 million in need of emergency food aid
- ✓ 2.3M+ children need humanitarian assistance with 33,000+ at high risk of death
- ✓ 2.2M+ are internally displaced
- ✓ 120,000+ survivors of sexual and gender-based violence (SGBV)
- ✓ 70,000+ refugees fled to Sudan
